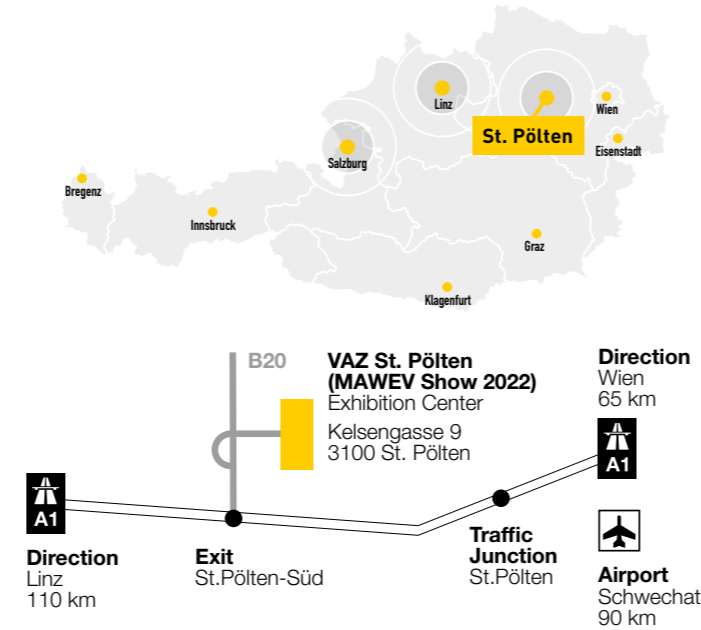

ALL OF TO ST. PÖLTEN: THE NEW TESTING AREA

The event venue, which is located approx. 65 km west of Vienna offers excellent conditions for exhibitors and visitors: the exhibition site is approx. 5 minutes from the A1 St. Pölten-Süd motorway exit and offers around 40.000m² of parking space for exhibitors and visitors in the surrounding area. In total, the exhibition grounds have an **exhibition area of more than 145.000m²** and a **hall area of 10.500m²**. In addition, the different ground conditions offer the best possible conditions for the leading event in the construction machinery sector.



TRUCK AREA INCL. TEST POSSIBILITY

A separate area puts the trucks in the centre of attention. Here everything revolves around the weighty commercial vehicles. On a separate test track, trucks can be tested by trade visitors under realistic conditions.

DOS AND DON'TS - THE DEMONSTRATION GUIDELINES

ACTION IS MANDATORY:

The machines must be in motion, i.e. they must be shown in realistic use.

„50:50“:

A maximum of half of the rented area (for open-air areas over 125m²) may be used for structures and stationary exhibition purposes. The remaining stand area is reserved exclusively for demonstration purposes only.

CURRENT MODELS ONLY:

Only new machines and demonstration devices are allowed to be used. The emphasis is on new models.

SAFETY FIRST:

Safety is a major issue at the MAWEV Show. Specific safety regulations for exhibitors and visitors for exhibitors and visitors guarantee that everything runs smoothly, especially when construction machines and vehicles are tested live on site. In addition, the entire exhibition area is fenced and guarded around the clock!

KEEP IT CLEAN:

After the end of the MAWEV show, the existing site must be restored. If this is not the case, the restoration will be arranged by the organiser. The costs for this are to be paid by the exhibitor concerned.
